The *Jinja Centre for Reconstructive Surgery and Global Surgery*, a unique centre for reconstructive surgery in East Africa, is going to be established in Jinja, Uganda by *ANDO – modular aid e.V.* and the *GoAide Foundation* from Cologne.

Together with the Ugandan partner *Bulamu Bukondhe Foundation*, *ANDO - modular aid e.V.* has created a high-level academic and surgical network, cooperating with *Interplast Germany*, members of the Universities of Cologne, Bonn and Stockholm and of the *International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC)* from Geneva.

The Surgical Centre will offer specialised care in plastic-reconstructive surgery for patients with burns, congenital anomalies, fistulas in women and hernias as well as serving as a training facility for surgeons and nursing staff from Uganda and neighbouring countries.

The clinic will allow sustainable long-term and high-quality surgical care for people from all over East Africa.
