Required Information

So that we may deal promptly with copyright application, please give a precise answer to the following questions:

Which work(s) do you wish to reproduce? Please provide the **full title** AND an **image** (jpg) or a **reference** to a published of the work(s).

1. What is the name of the publication/ the title of the article AND what is the author's name?
2. Will the works be the subject of a discussion, or will they be presented for comparison/reference purposes?
3. Do you intend to reproduce the work(s) in black and white or in colour?
4. What will be the size of the reproduction (cm x cm? AND dpi?)?
5. Do you require the print data, or do you already possess them?
6. What is the circulation of the publication?
7. What is your publishing deadline?

General Information

Should the requested print data available in the archive be of insufficient quality, we can arrange, where feasible and on request, to have this data produced at your expense by a photographer/ photo lab commissioned by us.

Reproduction
Stipulations

In the event of your application being successful, we would ask you to observe the following guidelines for the reproduction of the works of art.

1. The reproduced image must appear with the following acknowledgement:
Artist, title, year and the following credit line:

© Estate of Martin Kippenberger, Galerie Gisela Capitain, Cologne
2. Any deviation from the use set out in the original application must have the prior authorisation of the Estate of Martin Kippenberger.
3. Any such authorisation shall be limited only to the purpose for which it is given. Any further use (other publications, new editions, revised versions, advertising, TV or any other use related to the exhibition) shall require a separate application for authorisation.
4. The reproduced image must not differ from the original. This means that altering the colour of, cropping or adding text to the image is not permitted.
5. If the image is to be used on covers, posters, invitations, calendars, flyers or banners or as part of any other kind of publicity measure, a proof or a corresponding file of the final layout must be submitted to the Estate of Martin Kippenberger for its final approval before being sent to the printers.
6. In the case of an Internet-based publication, please inform the Estate as soon as the webpage is available online so that the Estate may verify it.
7. The electronic use of the print data made available is prohibited – this includes any storage systems or databases. All image data or data CDs shall remain the property of the Estate. Digital data must be removed from computers within 30 days.
8. Following publication, the Estate must be sent two specimen copies of the book/ magazine/ journal for the Estate's archive.
9. The permission granted by us in response to your image rights request solely covers the copyrights of Martin Kippenberger. The granting of permission does not imply a guarantee that the image(s) is/ are free of third-party rights or that third-party rights are being transferred hereby. If third party rights exist to an image, they must be obtained separately from the respective rights holder. Any provisions to the contrary, unless explicitly given and promised by us in the approval, do not apply.

In the event of failure to comply with these requirements or violations of copyright, appropriate financial penalties will be imposed.
